Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated was the first Greek-lettered organization founded by black college women on January 15, 1908, at Howard University in Washington, D.C. The purpose of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority is to cultivate and encourage high scholastic and ethical standards, to promote unity and friendship among college women, to study and help alleviate problems concerning girls and women in order to improve their social stature, to maintain a progressive interest in college life, and to be of service to all mankind.

Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Incorporated supports Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) and their contributions to the sorority and society. The Alpha Chi Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Incorporated will award its biennial Helen Adams Rouce Scholarship to high school seniors, in the Tulsa Metropolitan area who will attend an HBCU through 2025. The Helen Adams Rouce Scholarship Awards consists of three (3) scholarships, one (1st) \$5000, (2nd) \$3000 and (3rd) \$2000.

Enclosed is the scholarship packet that provides specific information regarding the scholarship criteria and instructions on how to apply. The scholarship recipients will be notified in April 2024 and will be invited to attend the May 2024 scholarship award ceremony.

HELEN ADAMS ROUCE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Helen Adams Rouce was an educator who started her teaching career in 1933 at Booker T. Washington School in Sand Springs, OK. She taught black students first through twelfth grades until 1966, when schools were desegregated. Rouce also taught mathematics and science at Booker T. Washington High School in Tulsa, OK until she retired in 1976. Rouce was also the first member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. in the Mid-Western Region to be honored for 75 years of continuous service.

Award Allocations

The Helen Adams Rouce Scholarship consists of three scholarship awards.

- 1- \$5000
- 2- \$3000
- 3- \$2000

Eligibility

The applicant must:

- Be a female senior attending a Tulsa, or metro area high school.
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Plan to attend an HBCU (historically black college or university)
- Provide proof of financial need

Instructions

Submit a complete application along with the following documents:

- A biographical sketch, including an essay entitled "The Importance of Pursuing an Education" (maximum of 2 pages typed, double spaced, times roman font, size 12, MLA format)
- A resume that includes extra-curricular activities, community service, high school honors, organizations, offices held
- A copy of ACT or SAT scores
- An official seven semester high school transcript in a sealed envelope from the registrar's office
- Three letters of recommendation (one REQUIRED from a teacher or counselor at your school, two other letters Family members are not eligible to write letters of recommendation)
- A personal photo attached to the upper right-hand corner of application (will not be returned)

A complete application and all supporting documents must be postmarked no later **April 30, 2024.** Mail all documents in one envelope to:

HELEN ADAMS ROUCE SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT

- 1. A financial need must be established by providing proof.
- 2. The scholarship recipient must attend a historically black college or university (HBCU) to receive this scholarship. The scholarship recipient forfeits the scholarship if she does not attend an HBCU. In this event, the scholarship committee reserves the right to award the scholarship to another applicant.
- 3. The scholarship recipient must have a grade point average of at least 2.5.
- 4. The scholarship recipient must provide proof of official enrollment. The scholarship will be awarded only after proof of official enrollment (after official university drop/add deadline) is received.
- 5. Scholarship funds will be made payable to the student or guardian.
- 6. Notification must be given to the Scholarship Committee by the recipient within ten (10) days for any changes in the initial application criteria.
